INFORMATION FOR COMPETITORS

General

- 1 **The South African National Defence Force Championship and the National Combat Rifle Championships are conducted annually over a period of 6 days.**

Eligibility

- 2 **The Championship are open to the following members who have been selected or nominated by their respective arms of service and/or Provinces (Refer to Rule 7 in the Rulebook)**
 - a **SANDF Regular Force**
 - b **SANDF Reserve Force**
 - c **South African Police Service**
 - d **South African Correctional Service**
 - e **Invited International Teams**
 - f **Properly Constituted Clubs**

- 3 **The SACRA rulebook 1st Edition, January 2010 will be the official rules for the 2010 Championships.**

Briefings

- 4 **Briefings will take place on dates, times and places as announced in the programme as well as from time to time during the Championship.**

Weapons

- 5 **Safekeeping facilities are available at the SACRA offices for all the Service and/or Competition rifles.**
- 6 **No private or service handguns may be carried on a person on the range.**

Range Complex

- 7 **Range accommodation and or tents must be booked well in advance via the SACRA Secretary.**
- 8 **The speed limit on all the range complex roads will be 40 km/h, wild animals roam, please beware as they have right of way.**
- 9 **Lights out and silence will be from 22h00. Please adhere, severe penalties for transgression.**

Armourer

- 10 **An armourer will be available on the range to repair unserviceable weapons. The armourer will also carry out random inspections on the range on instruction of the range officer. A Weapons inspection for all competitors will be held as per time and place on the program.**

Presentations and prizegivings

- 11 **Attending the final prize giving competitors are to adhere to the following strictly enforced dress code:**
- a. Sport Blazer and Tie (No jeans and/or takkies) or**
 - b. service personnel are allowed to wear Traditional Unit/ Service dress as per Military Dress code 1B(Stepouts with medals) or 5A(Mess Dress)**

Preparation of butts

- 12 **The last detail in the butts for the day will be responsible to fit new target sleeves on the frames and prepare the butts for the next day's shoot. The preparations of the range for the National Championships will be done by the SANDF Regular Force members.**

Merit medals

- 13 **Competitors who reach the Top 100 stage will each receive a commemorative medal which will be awarded on the range before the start of Match 17.**
